To accommodate PPA, SATs booster groups and visiting P.E. specialists, P.E. (which will be athletics and striking/fielding games) will take place when we can go outside or have a hall period. Please could children keep a P.E. kit and trainers in their lockers as we need to be flexible?

Our RE topic this half term is 'The Work of the Apostles', which gives us the opportunity to look at the disciples chosen by Jesus, the growth of the Early Christian Church and the impact of Pentecost.

In French we will explore the conversational use of varied nouns and verbs in relation to the children's experience.

In ICT we will look at Spreadsheets.
