Well, SATs is finally over and again, a huge well done to all of Year 6 for their calm, sensible approach and their desire to do their best for themselves and for St Anne's; we now look forward to our final few weeks in Year 6.

Our topic will be a Geography based one looking at Maps and Mountains. We will link this with other Subjects including ICT. We will run this alongside our Topic 'All the World's a Stage'. This is a practical topic where we incorporate music and Drama in preparation for our Y6 Leaver's play. There is also quite a lot of D&T as we also make all our own props.

Our Literacy focus will be on Play scripts as we practise our play and on character development and dialogue in narrative.

In Mathematics, we will look more closely at Real Life problems, including those related to Shape and space and Time. We will also be exploring algebra in preparation for High School.

For our last Science Topic, we will be covering the unit 'Evolution' which involves looking at how we have discovered our prehistoric past.

This half term we will continue to work on athletics and track skills. We will also be playing team games, including rounders and cricket.

Our remaining R.E Topic 'Called to Serve', relates Christ's teaching to the early Christian Church and to our own lives. We think about people who were, and are called to serve God and what that calling may look like for young Christians today.
